Fallon Survey

Paul Fallon

Mr. Fallon explained the method used to attain the data. He said they conducted 300 random telephone interviews between January 4th and January 9th with a margin of error of 5.65%. He reviewed the results of each question stating based on those results the city is moving in the right direction. Satisfaction and contentment remains high within the community. Taxes and spending are at the hierarchy of public concern which has changed over the last few years. In 2013, school funding was the issue of concern. Mr. Fallon would be available for any future questions regarding the results.

Timeline for Charter Amendments

Mr. McHugh reviewed the timeline should Council decide to place anything on the November ballot. He suggested Council adhere to this to avoid special meetings or emergency legislation.




