




## Miss and Miss Jr. Beavercreek 2016



The purpose of this citizenship pageant is to select young women who represent the spirit of the community. The pageant is not based on just looks; the pageant prides itself on its long list of winners that have represented not only the city but themselves in a confident and upstanding fashion. The pageant is open to all female Beavercreek residents entering grades 6-12 this August. Applicants must reside in the City of Beavercreek or Beavercreek Township.

The many benefits of participating in the pageant include but are not limited to, building confidence, help with networking among community leaders, assisting in your community, build relationships that will last a lifetime, build public speaking and humanitarian experience. Those that go on to win are welcome to do as much or participate as little as they wish in the community after the crowning. There are only a few commitments and those are as follows, Participate in the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade (ride in car) and help for 2 hours the weekend of the Popcorn Festival in the children's area (usually painting faces or taking tickets).

**PROCEDURES:** Return the completed application along with the list of activities and three letters of reference to Parks & Recreation Department, 789 Orchard Lane, Beavercreek, OH 45434, Attn: Miss Beavercreek Pageant. Applications must be postmarked by May 15, 2016. Please include a \$40 check payable to City of Beavercreek, in memo of check please put Miss Beavercreek Pageant & Contestant's Name.

A panel of local civic and business leaders will review the applications in the areas of activities, recommendations, interviews and pageant participation. These categories were selected to include those that best represent the abilities needed to succeed and have a positive impact on our community.

The pageant will be held at Beavercreek High School on June 9 & 10 at 6pm. The contestants will be asked to attend on June 9<sup>th</sup> to complete the personal interview portion, learn the opening routine and to receive t-shirt. Categories judged for Friday night June 10<sup>th</sup> will be poise, content of speech, clarity of speech, ability to express themselves and confidence. Scores from both nights' events will be compiled. Girls will compete for prizes and the opportunity to participate in the 4<sup>th</sup> of July 2016 Beavercreek Parade and represent their city as Miss & Miss Jr. Beavercreek 2016.

## Contract 2016

1. Activities: Applicants will include a LIST of all participation in school or extracurricular activities including sports, academic clubs, employment, community service, volunteer activities, etc. with the signed contract.
2. Letters of Recommendation: Applicants may attach up to three (3) letters of recommendation from teachers, pastors or other references of your choice with the signed contract.
3. Interview: Interviews will be based on information provided in your application.
4. Pageant Appearance: The Pageant will be held at times stated; participants are expected to arrive on time (a few minutes early). If a participant is late, points may be deducted.
5. The following is a list of rules for finalists of the Miss and Miss Jr. Beaver Creek Citizenship Pageant:
  - A. The sash is only to be worn during official appearances as Miss and Miss Jr. Beaver Creek.
  - B. The dress code for Miss and Miss Jr. Beaver Creek will reflect the dress code at Beaver Creek High School. Miss and Miss Jr. Beaver Creek will never appear in inappropriate or immodest clothing while wearing the sash.
  - C. Miss and Miss Jr. Beaver Creek are expected to do their best to appear at city functions. Functions include, but are not limited to, 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade and Beaver Creek Popcorn Festival.
  - D. No negative comments regarding the Pageant should be made no matter where or how you place in the pageant.
  - E. Miss and Miss Jr. Beaver Creek are representatives of the city of Beaver Creek. As such, they are expected to be models of modesty, manners, and be an example of leadership at all times, not just while wearing crown and sash.
  - F. All current and former Miss and Miss Jr. Beaver Creek recipients are ineligible from competing for her same title. Current and former Miss Jr. Beaver Creek recipients are eligible to compete for the title of Miss Beaver Creek when age requirements are met.
6. Miss and Miss Jr. Beaver Creek 2016 recipients leaving the area earlier than 6 months after winning title will pass their title to the 1<sup>st</sup> runner up.



### People's Choice Box Information

Each year we have a people's choice award. This award goes to the contestant that has the most votes from the public. This encourages people to attend and to cheer on their favorite. Each contestant will make a box, jar or container to hold "votes"; each vote is \$1.00 and 50% of money will go to the winner regardless of where the contestant places in the pageant. The other 50% will go to Beavercreek Parks and Recreation Fourth of July Celebration.

Each container is to be decorated in a way that represents the contestant. Each container should have at least one photo of the contestant and the name of the contestant in a visible place. Each container should also have a slot for money and a way to open the container to obtain money so it can be counted. Feel free to be original and fun. You are welcome to take these with you at the end of the pageant. Containers not picked up will be thrown away at the conclusion of the pageant. Approximate size of container should be roughly the size of a shoe box or smaller.

### Opening Number Directions

Opening number routine is a small choreographed dance routine and requires NO dance experience. You will wear the t-shirt provided. Please do not cut or modify the shirt in any way until after the pageant. You are welcome to accessorize, bow in your hair, belt, shoes etc. to match but the shirt should be visible. This is an upbeat number and will be fun. You are not judged on how you do.

### Miss Photogenic

Miss Photogenic is an optional category and is open to all contestants. Only one will be awarded; you can win this in addition to another title. Miss Photogenic is an additional \$5.00 per photo. You can submit up to 5 photos, each photo should have your name and division on the back i.e.: Miss or Miss Jr.



## Schedule of Events

This is an example of the schedule and is subject to change and is to only use as a reference

### Thursday June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2016 (please bring a bottle of water and write your name on it!)

5:30 Contestants arrive. You should come ready for your interview. You are welcome to bring a change of clothes for your comfort.

6:00pm You will receive your contestant number, t-shirt, and explanation of the evening and what to expect as well as be instructed where to put your items/ clothes for the talent portion. You will go in numerical order for the evening; starting with the Miss Jr. (Middle School girls). You will bring your people's choice container the night of the pageant, not this night.

6:30-6:50 Speaker, This subject is usually Leadership and is a prominent community leader. This is a private event for the girls and gives them some time relax.

6:10- 8:30 While interviews are taking place contestants will be learning opening number and will have the opportunity to practice their talent. Please bring all shoes you will need as the floor will change based on the type of shoe and you want to be prepared!

8:30- 9:30 Girls will introduce themselves; receive their t-shirt that is provided and a few other surprises. Parents are welcome to attend the last 30 minutes of this rehearsal/ interview night.

### Friday June 10<sup>th</sup> 2016

6:00- 6:30 Girls arrive, bring all items for pageant. Parents WILL NOT BE PERMITTED BACK STAGE, NO EXCEPTIONS. If a parent is caught back stage your daughter can be disqualified. You should come ready, hair and makeup finished. There will not be time to get ready. You are welcome to bring make up to touch up during the evening.

6:30 Doors open to public (family is welcome to stay at 6 when they drop off if they like to take photos and to obtain a good seat.)

6:50- 7:00 Girls will be making sure they are stage ready and the program will start on time.

7:00 Welcome

7:05 Opening number

7:10 Introductions start (girls one by one introduce themselves) Name, School, Grade and a fun fact about them. (You will wear the t-shirt provided for this) You will change immediately into your gown as soon as you go back stage

7:20 Starting with juniors (middle school) girls will come out and walk in the stage. Following Miss Jr, High School Girls will walk the stage. Each girl will be introduced Name, activities, etc this is the BIO the girls write; it should not be more than 5 sentences. As soon as you are finished you will change into talent costume if needed.

8:00 Talent performances will start. We will start with Jr.'s since the high school girls will have just gotten off stage from introductions.

8:40 Girls will change back into gowns and take the stage for closing statements and crowning. You will change back into your gown as soon as your talent is over

8:45 Girls will line up according to number starting with Jr. and awarding Optional (photo, peoples and congeniality) then Miss Jr. 2<sup>nd</sup> & 1<sup>st</sup> runner ups and Miss Jr then moving to Miss 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> runners up and crowning Miss. All contestants that won an award will remain on stage for pictures.

9:00 Conclusion of evening. Photos will be taken for press release and family & friends will be able to join you on stage for pictures

### Evening Gown Bio Sheet

Please type/ print out 5 sentences describing you that you would like read while you walk in your evening gown. This should be on PLAIN white paper. See example below. It will be read slowly and should reflect who you are and what you want the audience to know about you. Keep in mind the judges already know everything from your interview. You will be judged on your walk, the way you carry yourself and the age appropriateness of your dress. All dresses should go to the floor. Your dress does not have to be expensive. We have had title holders purchase a dress from a thrift store and go on to win and have had girls re-wear prom and bridesmaid dresses as well. As long as you feel good in your dress that is all that matters.

Suzie Pageant is a rising sophomore at Beavercreek High School. Suzie is a member of Speech & Debate, a Junior Varsity Cheerleader and a second year member of D.I.R.T.T. Suzie enjoys camping and being an active member in 4-H. On the weekend it is not unusual to find Suzie planting flowers at the senior center or playing cards with her grandmother.
