CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Stone called the meeting to order followed by roll call

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Fourth of July

Ms. Farrell reviewed the history of the city's Fourth of July event. There are three options: if restrictions are still in place, work with the mall regarding fireworks and a virtual show with Mr. C; Option #2 is a combined event with the Mall at Fairfield Commons with Red, White and Brew; Option #3 would be a scaled event at Rotary Park. The mall is expecting an answer by the end of the month. Council discussed the options and expect there to still be COVID restrictions. There was discussion of the fundraising for the fireworks and sponsorship. There was discussion of option 3 if there are no restrictions by the governor or option one if the governor has restrictions in force.

Public Safety Information Sharing Network with Greene County (PSISN)

Chief Fiorita said there were no changes to the agreement which has to be signed every five years. The cost sharing between the entities remains the same and this is just a renewal.

Repeal and Replace of Chapter 137 of Codified Ordinances

January 19, 2021

Mr. Lounsbury reviewed the changes to the Ohio Revised Code regarding gun laws. Chapter 137 is not consistent with the Ohio Revised Code and these changes would bring the Ordinances up to code. He summarized the ORC's regarding the discharge of firearms on premises.

Resident Survey

Mr. Landrum asked Council about the possibility to doing a statistical survey in the fall and what subjects would be targeted in the survey.

Future Work Session Topics

Mr. Landrum asked if there were any topics that Council wished to have addressed at future work sessions. He asked Council to forward the topics to him.
