 (4) 2018 Rates per the City of Oakwood Water/Sewer survey. Based on the residential usage of 1,000 cubic feet/month.  
 (5) Income and school district averages are based on the number of the cities/villages with taxes.  
 Taxes are based on the 2017 property tax rate paid in 2018.
