Subject: Boil Advisory lifted for Greene County Sanitary Engineering customers in Swigart and Clyo. Kitridge Road and Saville Estates areas still remain under boil advisory.

Notice: Greene County Sanitary Engineering (GCSE) has lifted a boil for customers located in the Swigart and Clyo areas. **Kitridge Road and Saville Estates areas are still under boil advisory until further notice.** Water customers are asked to enter their service address into the search field of the map at www.daytonohio.gov/boiladvisory to display the boil advisory status for the address. [A non-interactive map showing boundary areas is available here](#) and is attached. Water curtailment request is still in effect for all affected areas. GCSE advises its customers in these areas to boil water for at least one minute before consuming and to try to curtail water use during this event. **Water curtailment request is still in effect for all affected areas.**

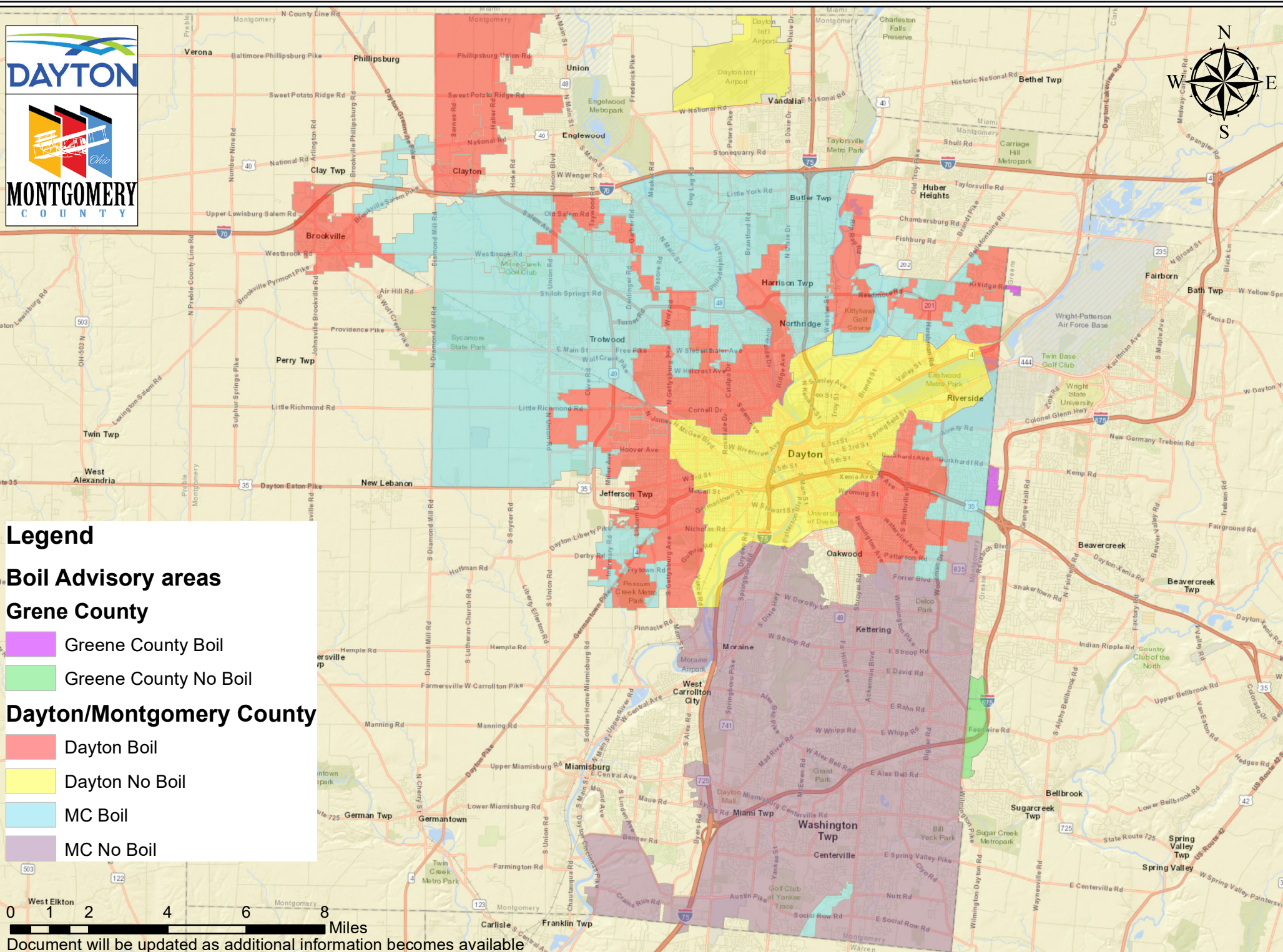

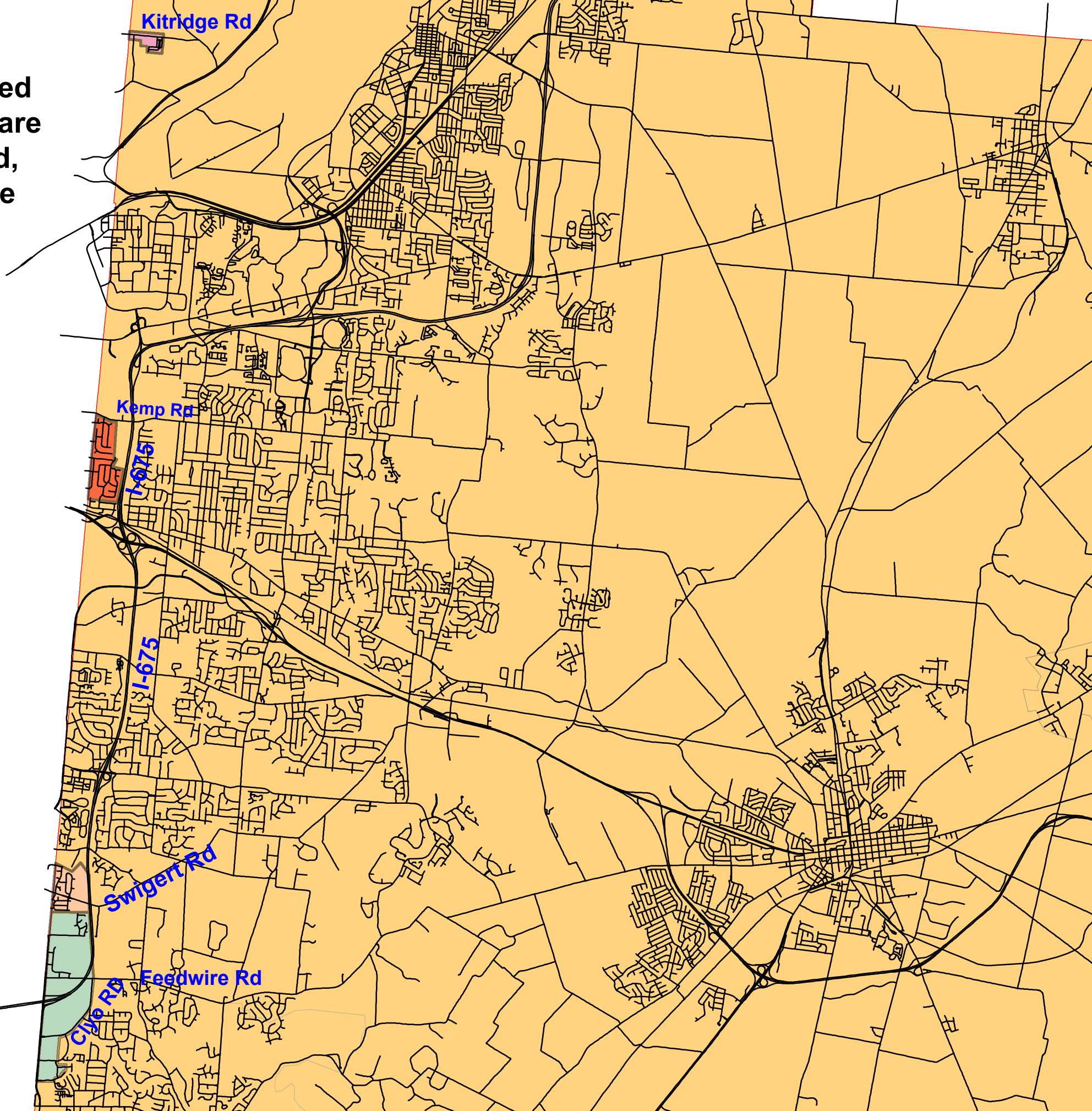

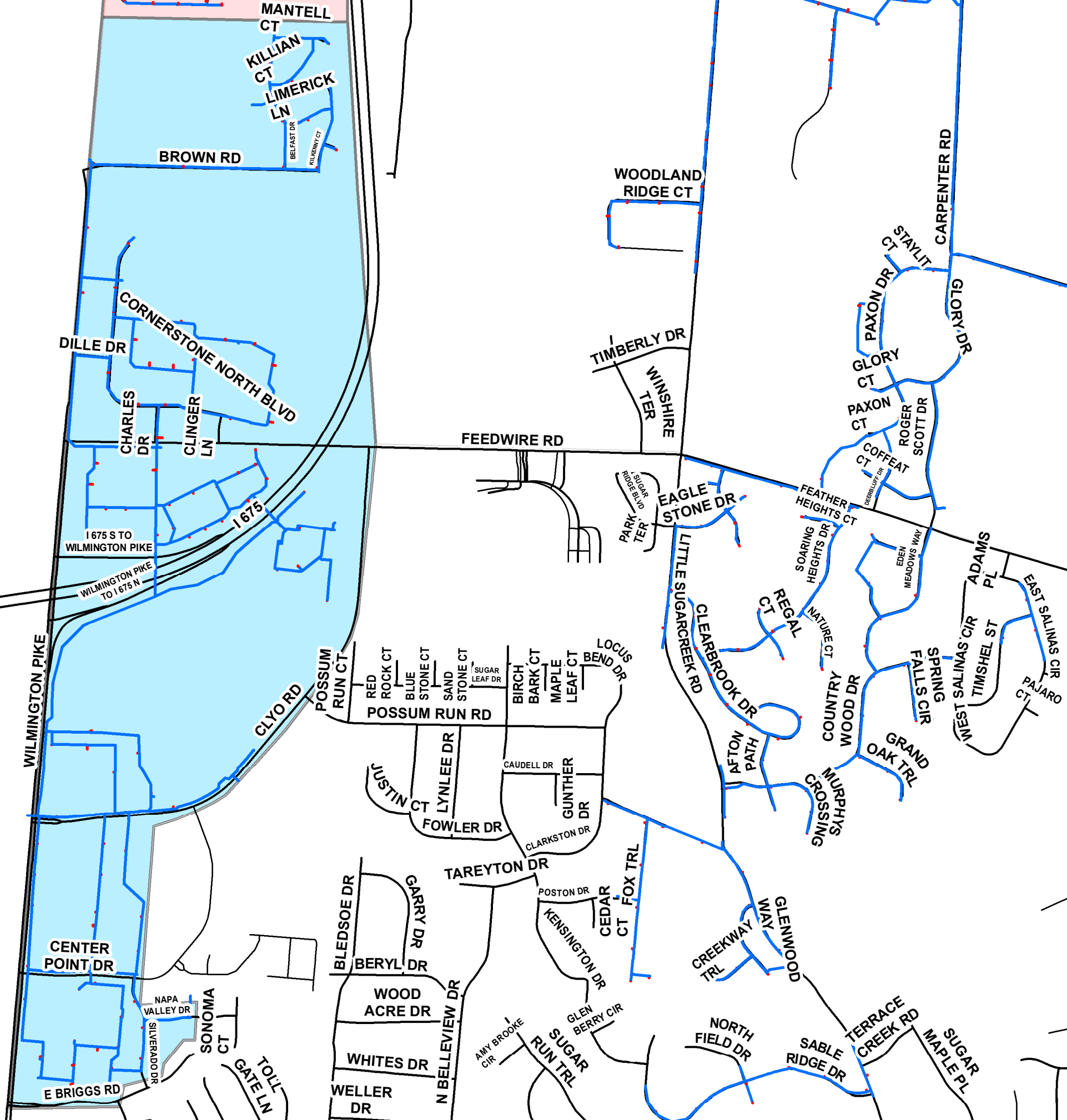

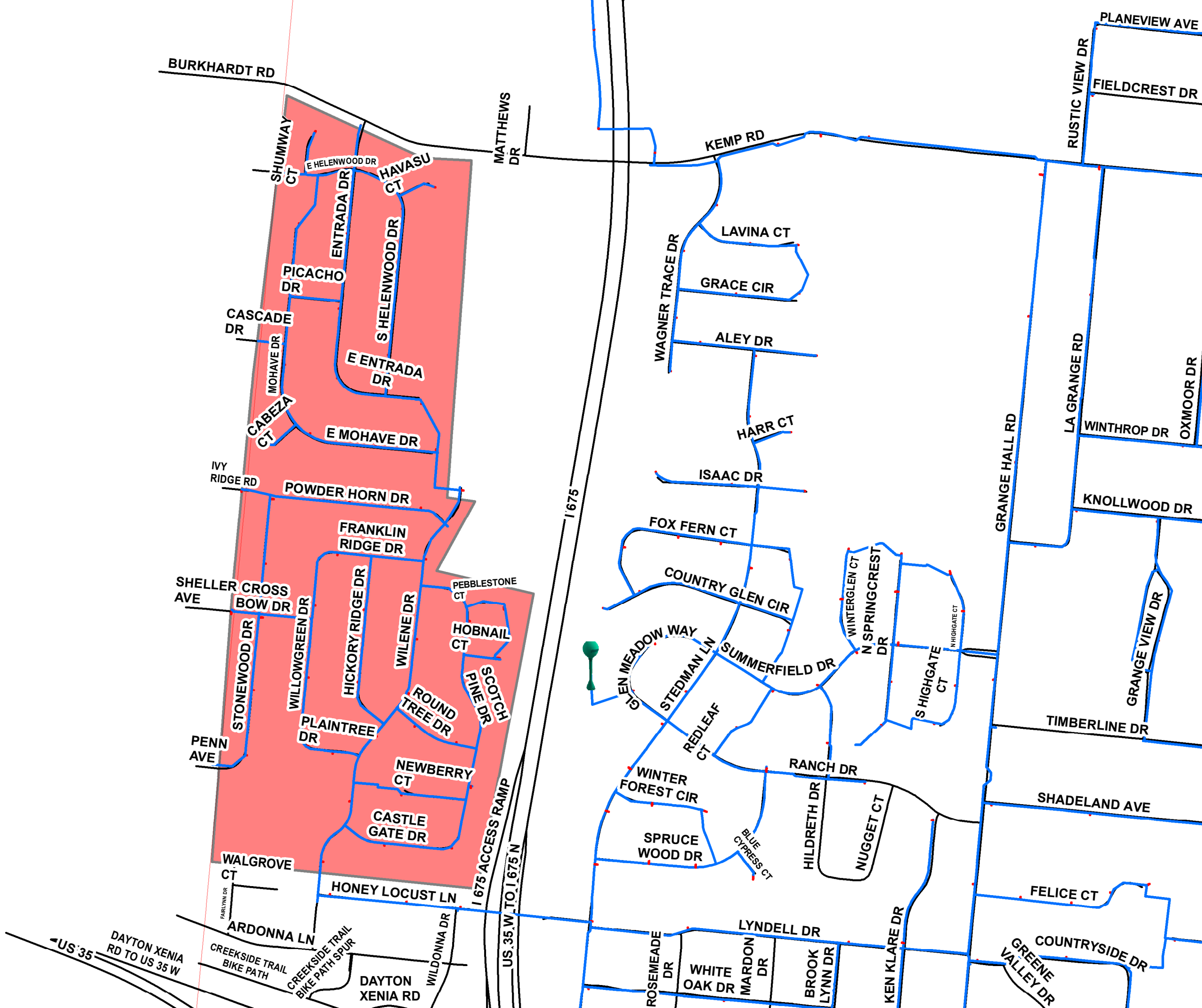


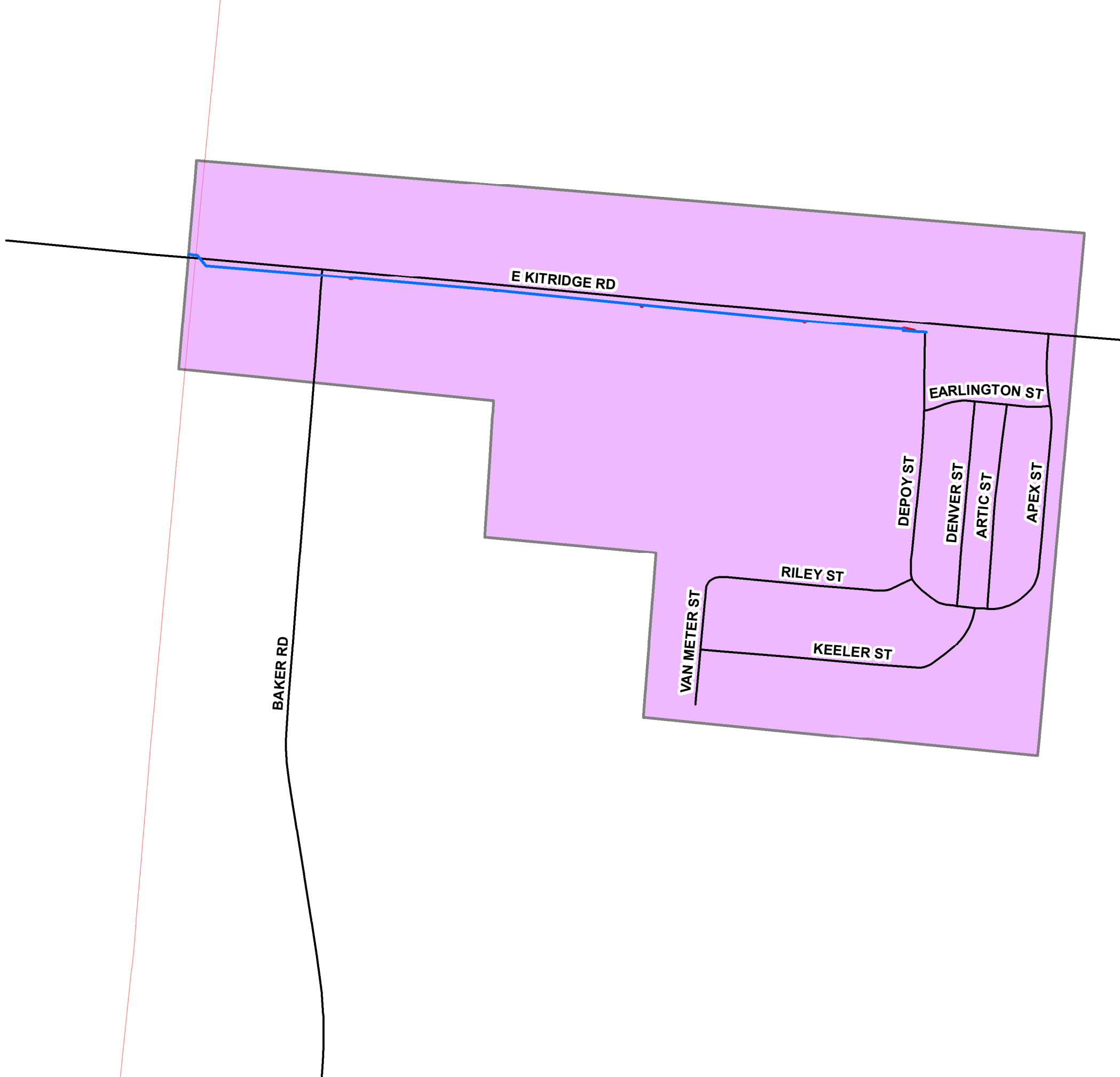
Areas impacted
